Presentation rules for Scientific Posters

Communications types

- All those research works related to pressure ulcers and other chronic wounds, of any subject and methodology, can be submitted.
- Abstracts must contain between 150 and 300 words (not including bibliography or title). They will follow the usual structure: introduction, objectives, material and method, conclusions and bibliography. They cannot contain graphics, figures or tables.
- There can be a maximum of 8 authors and the lead author will be cited first.
- The Scientific Committee decides that the posters must have a printed presentation in order to hang them in the Conference venue and to be able to defend them during the breaks if any of the attendees asks for more information. The Scientific Committee reserves the right to request additional information on the abstract.
- Members of the Scientific and Organizing Committee can present posters.
- The works must be unpublished and original (not published or presented in any other congress or forum).
- The final date for submissions will be **September 15, 2024**.
